Frequently Asked Questions

What is the School Readiness Program?

School Readiness is a state initiative designed to:

- Provide quality childcare for parents who are employed or pursuing further education or training
- Help preschool children develop the social, emotional and academic skills needed for kindergarten

What are the income guidelines?

Families must have gross annual family incomes that are **at or below 75%** of the median income in Connecticut.

What is 75% of the median income?

For 2013-2014, the 75% levels are:

- Family of 1 – 3 \$65,866
- Family of 4 \$78,411
- Family of 5 \$90,957

How does the School Readiness subsidy work?

The Windsor School Readiness grant pays participating programs a monthly stipend for each School Readiness child enrolled. Parents pay a family share based on their income and family size.

Are children with Care 4 Kids subsidies eligible for School Readiness placements?

Families who receive Care 4 Kids assistance may apply for School Readiness providing they meet all School Readiness eligibility criteria.
